When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmer's must have a minimum of a 'BB' time standard in each event they swim in the morning session (for their own age group) on Saturday and Sunday. The meet manager file has been set up as multi age so all age groups show time standards. Please follow the time standards in the entry file. For the afternoon session on Saturday, please see time standards below.

ENTRIES: This meet will be run using the HY-TEK MEET MANAGER. Export a meet entry file and e-mail it as an attachment. Upon completion of the meet, results, a commlink file and a MM Back up file will be posted on our website. Please send a hard copy of your entry with your entry summary and a check for entry fees. All entries should be submitted with Long Course times.

CONDUCT:

COVID-19:

No warm up or warm down in the pool. All participants must adhere to the meet marshalls' instructions. Athletes & families are to remain outside the pool and must maintain more than 2M of social distancing. Participants including family members not adhering to this standard will not be able to race and must leave the premises immediately - no refund. Masks must be worn while outside your vehicle and until the referee announces the athletes to be ready to start. Whistles will not be used.

Athletes will be able to view the meet via YouTube Live and will be able to get ready to enter the facility at the appropriate time using the coned / marked ready areas. Athletes are encouraged to bring a swim backpack into the facility when they are behind the blocks. (needs clean up, practice and video). Post race - mask on, parade out opposite starting end doors.

Participants shall watch the training video prior to attending. Participants must not be ill, must not have a family member who is ill, and in addition, athletes and their siblings must not feel nauseous, lethargic or low energy.

There will be no spectators.

All coaches and meet personnel must wear a facemask when out of their vehicle or off their bike.

No timers will be used. Only pads not buttons. If the pad fails or there is a soft touch, the athlete gets an NT.

No locker room or shower use. Athletes, Coaches and Meet Personnel may use the restrooms one at a time per gender and must wipe down all touched surfaces and put the toilet seat back up after use to indicate that it has been cleaned. Unfortunately, no other family members may use the facility restrooms.

the regular stuff:

In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 – the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Current Wisconsin and USA Swimming Rules will be used at this meet. In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 – the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited

DECK CHANGE:

Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.
